**County College Applicant:**

1. A completed application for the scholarship
2. An official college transcript
3. A letter of recommendation from a college professor
4. Two (2) letters of reference from previous teachers, advisors, coaches, or employers

Funds will be released on or about October, 2019 after receiving copies of a letter of acceptance and an official schedule of courses taken or other proof of enrollment.
